## Friday 1st Dec

Our community members and allies in North Somerset are invited to join the North Somerset LGBT+ Forum at Grove Park on Friday 1st December for our World AIDS Day vigil. Arrive 6pm for a 6.30pm start. The vigil is taking place to remember those whose lives have been lost to AIDS, to celebrate the lives they had, to understand the progress that has been made to date, and to better understand the work that is still being done across the world to combat HIV & AIDS as this is still an issue in many countries.

Attendees will be invited to tie Red Ribbons around the Bandstand which will remain in place for the weekend as a remembrance of these lives lost, and are encouraged to listen to a few of our guest speakers who will be speaking for a few short minutes during the evening about their own personal experiences, the support available out in our communities, and to encourage self testing and good practices.

Unfortunately, we are unable to allow real candles/tealights within this event, however you are encouraged if you wish to bring a battery

to hold during the event. The

Forum will also have some of these positioned around the Bandstand during the evening.






